The Vancouver Canucks play hockey here.






FOLLOW THE RULES

LINE UP

When you arrive at Rogers Arena


FIRST

Look at your ticket for your gate number

THEN

Line up outside your gate


Stay close to parents, family or friends because it might be noisy.



SHOW TICKET

After you wait in line at the gate:

- 1. Show your ticket to the Rogers Arena Staff.
- 2. They will scan your ticket.
- Then, you will go through security.



SECURITY

At security, listen to the staff


FIRST

Open your bag and show them what is inside

THEN

Walk through the metal detector

They might ask you to put your hands on your head.



GUEST SERVICES

Staff are at Rogers Arena to help. If you need assistance, ask a staff member or go to Guest Services.

You can borrow a sensory kit at Guest Services with headphones, sensory toys, a game schedule, and more.

There are guest services desks at Sections 104, 114, and 311





SENSORY RESOURCE KIT

The sensory resource kit contains:



NOISE CANCELLING HEADPHONES

These help make the arena sound quieter.



SENSORY TOYS

These give you something to figet with, if you need.



A GAME SCHEDULE

This helps you know what's happening and when.




ARENA MAP

This lets you know how to get around the arena.



ID BRACELET

This helps in case you get lost. Write the name and contact information of a parent, guardian or friend on this bracelet.



CONCOURSE

This is the concourse.

You will walk through it to find your seat. This is also where the concession and bathrooms are.

It can get crowded and loud before the game, during intermissions, and after the game.




FIND SEATING

Once you're in the arena, you can find your seat. Your ticket will say your section and seat number.

If you need help finding your seat, ask a Rogers Arena staff member for help.





BEFORE THE GAME

There will be lots of people in the arena and it might be very loud.

Before the hockey game starts, there will be loud music and colourful lights.

Then, the announcer will tell us to stand up and sing Oh Canada. You can sing along if you know the words.

If you can't stand up, that's okay. You can stay seated.







WATCH THE GAME

After O Canada, the game will start.

You can cheer "Go Canucks Go" or "Let's Go Canucks!"

When not cheering, use your indoor voice and keep your hands and feet to yourself.

If you need a break or want to move, you can go for a walk in the concourse.

GOAL

When the Canucks score a goal, there is a loud horn, music will play and everyone will CHEER!

If it is too loud, you can cover your ears or put headphones on.

If the other team score, you can say "Too Bad!" and keep cheering for the Canucks.

Remember, you can get noise cancelling headphones Guest Services.





INTERMISSION

There will be two breaks during the game called "intermission."

You can go to the bathroom or get some food. You might have to wait in line.

You can also stay in your seat. Sometimes, there are fun activities to watch during intermission.





WATCH THE GAME

There are three periods and two intermissions in the game.

If the game is tied after the third period, they will play overtime until one team scores.

If no one scores in overtime, they will have a shootout to determine the winner!






AFTER THE GAME

When the game is finished, everyone will start to leave.

The concourse will be very busy and crowded.

You can choose to wait in your seat until there is a smaller crowd in the concourse.



HOME TIME

Now it's time to go home.

You will leave the concourse with the person that you came with.

If you want to watch another hockey game, you can buy a ticket or watch the Canucks on TV!
